## DECLARATION OF NO WAKE ZONE ON LAKE PULASKI

Pursuant to STATEWIDE EMERGENCY WATER SURFACE USE RESTRICTION, and

Pursuant to Minnesota Rules 6110.300-6110-3800, and

WHEREAS, because of extraordinary high water on Lake Pulaski due to historically high rainfall amounts across the State of Minnesota adversely affecting and causing harm to the shoreline of Lake Pulaski, there is a NO WAKE ZONE restriction of five miles per hour within 600 feet of the shoreline for watercraft at the elevation of 966.00 for the entire lake, and

WHEREAS, NO WAKE ZONE restrictions shall expire after 30 days from the date of this declaration, if no extension is granted by the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, and

WHEREAS, in no case shall the NO WAKE ZONE restrictions continue beyond the time when the Lake Pulaski reaches a level of 966.00, and

WHEREAS, the Wright County Sheriff's Office is responsible for the enforcement of this Declaration, and

WHEREAS, law enforcement and public safety personnel are exempt from the requirements of this declaration, and

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Buffalo, Minnesota, hereby declares

A NO WAKE ZONE ON LAKE PULASKI, BUFFALO, MINNESOTA.
